Re: Letter of Support, Senate Bill 95: Maryland Agricultural Preservation Foundation-Farmland Preservation Partnership Program

Dear Senator Conway and Committee Members:

As the Chair of the Maryland Commission on Climate Change, the Maryland Department of the Environment supports SB 95. This bill allows the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation to protect undeveloped land through a Farmland Preservation Partnership Program.

SB 95 is supportive of the State's smart growth and climate protection goals, addressed respectively by the Smart, Green and Growing Program and the Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Act of 2009. Protecting forested and agricultural land helps to keep development closer to population centers, which keeps vehicle miles traveled to a minimum, preventing emissions of greenhouse gases and other pollutants. Furthermore, when forested and agricultural land is left undeveloped it is able to sequester carbon dioxide, the leading greenhouse gas associated with climate change.
