The City of Frederick was founded in 1745 and is the second largest city in Maryland with a population of nearly 80,000 people.

Environmental Achievements:

- Adopted a climate action plan identifying strategies to reduce the City government's GHG emissions by 50% from 2010 levels by 2030 and by 100% by 2050.
- Launched a residential compost pilot that diverted 34.6 tons of compostable material to a local composting facility.
- Continued restoration of Carroll Creek significantly increasing habitat and improving water quality while making the area a destination for residents and visitors.
- Installing EV Charging stations and upgrading to
 - LED streetlights.
- Achieved LEED for Cities certification.
