Extension to the Expedited Tidal Wetlands License to Repair or Replace Structures Damaged by Hurricane Isabel

License: Issued September 23, 2003, by the Wetlands Administrator and affirmed by the Maryland Board of Public Works November 12, 2003

Original Expiration: September 20, 2004

Revised Expiration: September 20, 2005

Time to Complete Work: Completion of work must occur on or before September 20, 2006

Authority: Code of Maryland Regulations 23.02.04.05C

Authorized Activities: As stated in the Expedited Tidal Wetlands License

Conditions for Extended Expedited License:

1. Licensee must comply with Expedited License Conditions numbers one through five.
2. Licensee must have obtained written local approvals between September 23, 2003, and September 20, 2004, inclusive. Local approval must remain valid through activity completion.
3. A licensee who has not completed activity by September 20, 2005 must:
 - . Have substantially started construction or contracted with licensed contractor as of September 20, 2005;
 - . Obtain prior written approval from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District; AND
 - . Must complete activity no later than September 20, 2006.

Failure to comply with this Extended Expedited License exposes both the property owner and the contractor to monetary penalties under § 16-502 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

Consumer Advisory

Using a contractor licensed by the Maryland Home Improvement Commission (MHIC) to repair or replace piers, docks, wharfs and boat ramps on residential properties assures protection under MHIC laws and from the Home Improvement Guaranty Fund, which may provide up to \$15,000 for poor workmanship or failure to perform work.
